ORDEAL

This list is intended for Induction Candidates and Elangomats, and contains all the items to bring to your induction! Please note: items marked with an asterisk (*) are REQUIRED.

- *Current BSA Medical Form and copy of insurance card
- Class A (Field) Uniform — Wear your uniform to the Ordeal

BACKPACK: Pack the following things in a backpack. You will be hiking while carrying it, so keep that in mind when packing. This backpack will be the only thing you will be able to take with you on Friday night. You will not have access to your backpack from the time you leave your campsite on Saturday morning until Saturday evening.

- *Tarp
- *Sleeping Bag
- *Water Bottle (with water)
- *Flashlight
- *Work Gloves
- *Work clothes and sturdy boots. You will be given an opportunity to change into these after the Call-Out.

DUFFLE OR OTHER CONTAINER: Pack the following things in a duffel bag or another container. This container will be left at Stamler dining hall. You will have access to this container on Saturday late afternoon.

- *Towel, washcloth, and shower shoes.
- *Change of clothes
- *Personal hygiene items (tooth brush, deodorant, etc.)
- *Class A (Field) uniform (will be left in this container after changing Friday night)
- *Personal tent
- *Money for OA Trading Post - got to have OA bling!
- *Swim trunks
- *Anything else you would want to pack for a weekend at camp
