Space for all MB classes is limited, please pre-register. You may use the attached registration form and submit it to the council office by January 31, 2018 with the registration fees. Online registration is also available through <a href="https://www.bgbsa.org">www.bgbsa.org</a> (click on the event link in the calendar) and is recorded at the time of registration. Mail-in registrations will be entered into the system as they are received and as quickly as time allows. You will receive a confirmation email after your completed registration is entered into the registration system. *Registrations cannot be accepted after January 31, 2018 without special approval*. Please note any special needs a Scout may have regarding dietary restrictions or physical access to classrooms on the Registration form in order that we may attempt to accommodate them as best possible.

The Registration fee is \$10.00/Scout. Adult leaders attending the fair must be identified on the registration form and pay the lunch and insurance fee of \$4.00/day which should be included with your troop's registration.

## **Adult Training Opportunities:**

*This is Scouting* course training will be offered on the morning of the first Saturday followed by Boy Scout *SM/ASM Leader Specific* training. Attendance on both Saturdays will be required to complete these courses due to their combined length. The training is free; however, a fee of \$8.00 will be charged to cover lunch and insurance.

To register for the above adult training add adult names and course(s) desired <u>along with lunch and insurance</u> <u>fees</u> to the Scouts MB Registration form. Registration will also be possible at the fair. All adult training classes will begin at 9:00 AM.

At this point CPR/AED and First Aid adult training will not be offered. Should that change, a separate notice will be sent out to everyone.

Notes to Scoutmasters: It is the Scoutmaster's responsibility to review each Scouts MB choices to ensure they have the skill level, rank, maturity, etc. to complete the MB before approving them to work on the MB. Each Scout is expected to be prepared for their first class by, bringing a notebook and pencil, and having obtained and read the most recent MB book. Each Scout is encouraged to come to the fair in full class "A" Uniform.

Please carefully review minimum age, rank and pre-requisites as you select classes for your Scouts. To ensure MB completion at the fair, many of the badges offered have requirements that should be completed during the 3 week period between Saturdays. Please help your Scouts complete all homework for each MB they plan to take to allow them to accomplish this goal.
